THE CONDITIONS OF THIS SALE ARE AS FOLLOWS:

Danielle and Rusty Manire and Oregon Bordoodles,
Hereinafter referred to as "Seller" and "OBD".

This puppy sales contract entered into on the date signed below between Danielle and Rusty Manire, (Seller) and _____, (buyer).

SELLER OBLIGATIONS:

This puppy is guaranteed to be in good health, to the best of the seller's knowledge. The buyer has 72 hours, from the date of ownership in which to have the puppy checked by a licensed veterinarian. If there is an incurable or adult-life altering health concern, you may return the puppy to us, at your expense, on the day following the vet exam, along with a veterinarian's statement stating the problem. You will receive a full refund of the purchase price of the pup less any shipping fees. (Exclusion: This does not include the presence of parasites and also does not apply to a health problem resulting from an injury or accident. All medical expenses are the sole responsibility of the buyer.)

Virus, bacterial and upper respiratory infections, hernias and parasites are not covered in the health guarantee.

GUARANTEES:

Two Year Hip Guarantee against genetic moderate or severe hip dysplasia. A high percentage of all canine hip dysplasia is related to poor nutrition, therefore we require that your Oregon Bordoodle be fed Life's Abundance dog food (or Nulo if in Canada) and NuVet Plus supplement for the first 26 months of his/her life in order to qualify for this 2 year health guarantee. OFA or Pennhip are the sole and only judges in determining hip dysplasia.

Five Year Free Replacement Puppy. Your Oregon Bordoodle must be fed Life's Abundance dog food (or Nulo, if in Canada) and NuVet Plus supplement for their entire lifetime. If your Oregon Bordoodle does not reach the age of 5 years old, you will be eligible to get a free replacement puppy of equal value.

The Free Replacement Puppy Guarantee is of your Oregon Bordoodle does not apply in cases of accidental death, neglect, abuse, injuries or medication reactions.

This puppy is guaranteed against being affected by all genetic diseases listed below. If your Oregon Bordoodle is affected by any of these diseases as proven by Pawprint Genetics Labs, we will offer a replacement puppy as soon as one becomes available OR refund your purchase price for said puppy within 90 days of us receiving DNA result certificate from Pawprint Genetics.





Genetic Diseases included in this guarantee are:

- Degenerative Myelopathy
- GM2 Gangliosidosis (Poodle Type)
- Neonatal Encephalopathy with Seizures
- Osteochondrodysplasia
- Progressive Retinal Atrophy, Progressive Rod-Cone Degeneration
- Von Willebrand
- Collie Eye Anomaly
- Degenerative Myelopathy
- Intestinal Cobalamin Malabsorption (Border Collie Type)
- Multidrug Resistance 1 (Ivermectin Sensitivity)
- Neuronal Ceroid Lipofuscinosis 5
- Sensory Neuropathy
- Trapped Neutrophil Syndrome
- Double merle (M/M) induced blindness or deafness

If the puppy is sold as a service dog or breeder (additional Breeder contract applies) this contract is to be followed. I do not guarantee that a puppy that is sold as a breeder will produce any litters at any time during the dog's lifetime. I do not guarantee that a puppy that is sold as a breeder will have the same quality as their parents or any other dog in their pedigree. Seller does guarantee a puppy will be able to complete service dog training. Although all of our pairings are done in mind with creating the highest possibility of intelligence, work ethic and gentleness possible, every puppy is different.

Seller does not guarantee the intensity of color said puppy may develop with age. It is understood that degrees of color in Bordoodles vary from dog to dog. It is understood that hormones, climate, and genetics play an important role in color intensity and that even though a Bordoodle puppy may be a specific shade/color/markings when sold, it is possible that said puppy could darken or lighten or change after being spayed/neutered, from season to season or as it grows older.

Breeder makes no guarantees regarding the loss of the puppy due to accidental death, theft, sickness due to lack of vaccinations, etc., or any other loss beyond the Breeder's control except as stated above. Breeder will not refund money in whole or part for any reason other than stated in the guarantee.

The original buyer of the dog has the right to a replacement puppy from the next available and comparable litter considering the following criteria have been met:

1. The original buyer must own the puppy.
2. The puppy must not have sired or whelped a litter.
3. The puppy must not have been overfed or overweight, underfed or underweight.
4. Buyer must show veterinary statement of diagnosis of hip dysplasia by the OFA or Pennhip or retinal atrophy (progressive) by CAER, along with a copy of the x-rays or vision exam results prior to the 26 months of age and document stating dog's name, description and microchip number.
5. Buyer must have fed this dog Life's Abundance (or Nulo, if in Canada) dog food and NuVet Plus supplements for the first 26 months.

Note: The use of Trifexis, Comfortis, Credelio, Nexgard or Simparica are strongly advised against and the use of any of these products will completely void your Health Guarantee.





BUYER OBLIGATIONS:

The buyer(s) shall provide proper nutrition, vet care, shelter and exercise. The pup shall be socialized properly to include other people outside the family, other dogs, and strange places. Obedience classes are strongly recommended for your puppy.

In the case of sudden death of puppy, breeder must receive a written notice of puppy's death from owner's vet, along with a necropsy report indicating the cause of death. We also reserve the right to acquire a DNA sample from the puppy to determine the dog or puppy as one of our lineages.

First Right of Recovery: If buyer is unable or decides not to care for the puppy purchased, Oregon Bordoodles retains the right of recovery of the puppy at the buyer's expense. The buyer must notify Oregon Bordoodles as to the change in circumstances and give the seller first right to the dog before any other action is taken. This includes and is not limited to selling the dog to another buyer. Buyer agrees that if this they no longer can keep the puppy/dog in their home, the dog will be returned to Oregon Bordoodles at the buyer's expense.

The buyer will also maintain up to date vaccines & dewormings (as specified in "Medical Form", and to keep the puppy/dog in humane conditions and provide proper food, water, and shelter. Failure to follow the above contract completely will result in "A Breach of Contract" and shall make this contract null and void.

Buyer must sign their Oregon Bordoodle puppy up for the Trupanion free 30 day Pet Insurance beginning the day the puppy leaves Oregon Bordoodle's property. Failure to do so will result in their puppy being held at our home until done so, or until we decide to place said puppy with an alternative family.

Failure to follow any or all of Buyer Obligations noted here will result in buyer releasing the dog back into the care of Oregon Bordoodles and/or up to \$5,000 compensation to Oregon Bordoodles to care for, treat and reassess dog. If puppy/dog is medically insured at the time the incident or investigation into neglect, injury, etc begins, buyers must transfer said insurance to Oregon Bordoodles for Oregon Bordoodles to take over policy but buyers may not cancel it unless Oregon Bordoodles refuses said policy.

Breeder's Rights:

Breeder is in no way responsible for any vet bills made after puppy/dog leaves the care of Oregon Bordoodles.

Breeder shall not be responsible for death or injury of said puppy/dog due to negligence or carelessness of the Buyer, any airline, live animal carrier, it's agents or employees.

Breeder has the right to, at any time; decide to stop breeding Oregon Bordoodles. In this case, no replacement puppies shall be given and this contract is null and void.

Breeder makes no guarantees regarding the loss of the puppy due to accidental death, theft, sickness due to lack of vaccinations, etc., or any other loss beyond the Breeder control except as stated above.





Breeder will not refund money in whole or part for any reason other than stated in the guarantee.

Breeder has the right to rescue this puppy/dog if we find that it is being mistreated, neglected, or abused and you do not voluntarily return it. Also, any mistreatment, neglect or abuse of the animal automatically voids all guarantees given by us.

Reproduction Clause:

Buyer understands and agrees that this dog is being sold as "Pet Quality". This dog is NOT being sold with ANY "Breeding Rights". If this dog breeds via Natural breeding or Artificial Insemination, buyer agrees to pay Danielle Manire a \$5,000 "Breeding Rights" fee within 30 days. Failure to do so will result in lawful collection of fees and all legal costs will be the responsibility of buyer noted here.

Buyer and Seller agree to ALL of the above stated terms.
